TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 1

AM Breakfast at leisure is served in the Marriott Hotel, Quito.

The rest of your day is at your leisure. Your room will be available until check-out of the hotel late afternoon. Please contact the KLAS-TV Hospitality Desk if you have any questions about your departure later today.

PM Transfer from the hotel to the airport for your flight to Lima, Peru.

6:00 PM Depart Quito on Taca Peru flight # 28

8:05 PM Arrive Lima, Peru (399 fect)

Guests will be transferred by motorcoach to the luxurious Miraflores Park Hotel, located 45 minutes away from Lima's Jorge Chavez International Airport. Your bags will be delivered to your room by pre-tipped bellmen.

The rest of the evening is at leisure. Dinner is on your own tonight.

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 2

AM An early buffet breakfast is served at leisure in the hotel's restaurant.

If you decide to leave excess luggage in the hotel in Lima, you may have it stored in the luggage room upon check out. Remember that you can only bring one suitcase (44 lbs) and one carry-on with your on board.

7:45 AM Transfer from the hotel to the airport. Upon arrival at the airport you will check in for your flight to Cuzco.

9:50 AM Depart Lima on Lan Peru flight # 35

11:00 AM Arrive Cuzco (11,600 feet)

Guests will be transferred by motorcoach to the spectacular Monasterio Hotel. Your bags will be delivered to your room by pre-tipped bellmen. You may feel uncomfortable due to the change in altitude. We advise you to take it easy this afternoon if you are experiencing any symptoms of altitude sickness. Lunch is on your own today.

PM City Tour Cuzco

Late afternoon, your English-speaking guide will take you on a tour of the historical center of this attractive city. You will visit the 16th century Cathedral and its Colonial art. Other stops include the Plaza de Armas and Santo Domingo's Convent.

The rest of your day and evening is at leisure.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3

AM Buffet breakfast is served in the hotel's restaurant.

If you decide to leave excess luggage at the Monasterio Hotel in Cuzco, you may have it stored in the luggage room upon check out. We advise that you only travel with small backpack per person to Machu Picchu so that you avoid carrying excess luggage with you on and off the train.

You transfer to the train station to board the train to Machu Picchu – the 'Hiram Bingham', a luxury train service bearing the crest of the famous explorer. Get ready to follow his historic footsteps in style!

9:00 AM-12:30 PM

'Hiram Bingham' to Machu Picchu

The scenery on the 3.5 hour train journey is simply spectacular. You travel through the Sacred Valley, passing by lush, green fields and colorful villages in the foothills of the Andes. From here on there are wonderful vistas of the mountains and deep in its dramatic canyon, the beautiful Urubamba River running through the Sacred Valley. Brunch is served on

board the train.



Guided Tour of Machu Picchu

Upon arrival at Aguas Calientes, you transfer by small buses to the entrance of the ruins to begin your tour. Machu Picchu rises to an altitude of 8,000 feet between the Huayna Picchu (young peak) and the Machu Picchu (old peak). It lies within the spectacular framework provided by the exuberant vegetation of nearby jungle and the rugged landscape. The ruins are situated on the eastern slope of Machu Picchu in two different areas: the agricultural and the urban. The latter includes the civil sector (dwellings, canalizations) and the sacred sector (temples, mausoleums, royal houses). The religious buildings in particular exhibit a high degree of perfection.

After the guided tour and stroll through the archeological site, you will be directed to the Sanctuary Lodge, where you can enjoy an afternoon tea and check into your room. Dinner will be served at the Sanctuary Lodge.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 4

For early birds it might be of interest to get up early, climb to the Sungate to watch the sun rise and see it cast its shadow on the ruins.

AM Buffet breakfast is served in the hotel's restaurant.

Your morning and afternoon are at leisure. You may re-enter the grounds of Machu Picchu or climb any of the various trails in the area. Lunch will be served in the hotel. You will not have access to your rooms after 9:00 AM. However, one dayroom will be made available for you to freshen up before your train ride back to Cuzco.

PM You will board the coach for your 25-minute transfer to the Aguas Calientes train station.

6:30 PM- 'Hiram Bingham' back to Cuzco

10:00 PM Back on board the 'Hiram Bingham', pre-dinner cocktails and live entertainment will be enjoyed in the bar. Afterwards, a four-course

a la carte dinner is served in the dining cars.

Upon arrival at Poroy station, you will be transferred to the Monasterio Hotel.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 5

AM Buffet breakfast is served in the hotel's restaurant.

Your morning is at leisure.

12:00 PM Depart Cuzco on Lan Peru flight # 26

1:25 PM Arrive Lima

Upon arrival in Lima you will be transferred back to the Miraflores Park hotel, where you will have access to your room until you depart the hotel later this evening.

Dinner is on your own this evening. Around 9:00 PM you will be transferred from the hotel to the airport to check in for your flight back to the US.
